11. Radioactive material shall be used only by, or under the supervision of, Lisa Duran.



13. The licensee shall conduct a physical inventory every six months to account for all sealed sources and/or devices received and possessed under the license. Records of the inventories shall be maintained for inspection, and may be disposed of following Division inspection.
14. Radiation detection instruments used to perform wipe test analysis shall be tested for proper operation in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
15. This license does not authorize commercial distribution of licensed material. Distribution is authorized under Nevada Radioactive Material License No. 03-11-0523-02.
16. Licensed material shall not be used in or on human beings.
17. Sealed sources or plated sources containing radioactive material shall not be opened by the licensee.
18. Except as specifically provided otherwise in this license, the licensee shall conduct its program in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in the documents including any enclosures, listed below. Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 459 shall govern unless the statements, representations and procedures in the licensee's application and correspondence are more restrictive than the regulations.
